SCHOOL UNIFORM

IMPORTANT

Although we have changed suppliers, our main school uniform has not changed. The only changes are:-

1. To introduce a polo shirt as a cooler option to the shirt and tie in the summer term. **N.B. This would be strictly for SUMMER TERM ONLY and would not be permitted as an alternative during the rest of the year.** Blue checked dresses would also remain an option in the summer term.
2. A slight change to the design of the PE top – this will be phased in and there is no need to replace current PE tops with the new design.
